Prayer in this present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant Licence of Arms to the petitioner.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ambala is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 13.6.2018 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ambala to consider and

decide the representation dated 13.6.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, respondent No.2 reaches to the conclusion that the request of the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the Arms Licence be issued to him as per provisions of the Arms Act, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority/respondent No.2 feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
