By way of this common judgment, two writ petitions, captioned above, are being disposed of having identical facts and legal issues involved therein. However, for brevity, the facts are being derived from CWP-28377-2013.

The petitioners seek issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representations submitted by the petitioners for considering the fortuitous

promotion granted to them as Assistant Sub Inspector as regular promotion from the date when they were given the same with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, the respondents are directed to forward their case for consideration before the Officers' Committee appointed by this Court vide judgment dated 04.03.2010, passed in ***Ranjit Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others***, CWP No.566 of 2010.

In view of the prayer made and without advertng to the merits of the instant case, the respondents are directed to relegate the case(s) of the petitioners to the Officer's Committee (ibid) for recommendations as regards the claim of the petitioners raised in the instant writ petition. The necessary exercise be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment.
