Petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 27.09.2016 (**P-4**).

This Court while issuing notice of motion passed the following order:-

*“ It is contended that vide advertisement dated 13.09.2016 (**Annexure P-3**), 90 posts of Sub Divisional Engineers (Civil) have been advertised by the Irrigation Department, Punjab, which have been increased to 145 posts, vide the subsequent advertisement dated 24.10.2016. In the first advertisement (**P-3**), 03 posts have been reserved for Physically Handicapped and have been increased to 05 by*

virtue of the second advertisement.

The grievance is that out of 05 posts, 03 have been reserved for Hearing Impaired and 02 for Locomotive Disorder and none for the Visually Impaired like the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage for 02.12.2016.

On the asking of the Court, Mz. Sudeepti Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State and prays for time to seek instructions.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner(s) undertakes to furnish requisite number of copies of petition to the learned State Counsel during the course of the day.

To be shown in the **urgent list.** ”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has been issued the appointment letter.

Dismissed as infructuous.
