The land of the petitioner measuring 7 kanal 9 marla, situated within the revenue estate of village Fazilpur, District Sonapat was acquired by the State of Haryana vide Award dated 12.05.1993. It appears that pursuant to the directions issued by this Court, the respondents, in terms of their policy dated 11.08.2016, invited applications from the oustees vide advertisement dated 16.01.2017. The petitioner also applied alongwith earnest money of Rs.3,86,000/- for a plot measuring 10 marla. Her grievance in the instant writ petition is that though draw of lots was to be held within 30 days but no such action has been taken so far and all the oustees are waiting for the outcome of draw of lots. The petitioner in this regard served the respondent-authorities with a legal notice dated 20.03.2018 but finding no response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the above-mentioned averments made in the writ petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to consider the claim

of the petitioner for holding of draw of lots of the applicants who have applied under the 'Oustees Policy' in response to the advertisement dated 16.01.2017. Let an appropriate decision be taken within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
