Petitioners are employed as Part-time Sweepers in the respondent-department. Even though petitioner No.3 was engaged on 01.03.1997, petitioner No.2 on 13.07.2000 and petitioner No.1 on 01.11.2000, their services have not been regularized. Though, in terms of policy dated 11.11.2003/27.02.2004, they ought to have been regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003. Particularly when person junior to them, such as Raj Kumar, who was employed on 01.04.2003, has since been regularized w.e.f. 01.04.2011. Petitioners purport to have even served the respondents with a legal notice dated 16.11.2017 (Annexure P7). But to no avail.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, as also the legal notice dated 16.11.2017 (Annexure P7), within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Needless to assert that

in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
