JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is serving as Senior Assistant with the Department of Secondary Education, Punjab. He has challenged his transfer from Amritsar to Barnala vide impugned order dated 28.07.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the transfer order has been passed based on false complaints without any proper inquiry and as a measure of punishment. It is not in dispute that the petitioner belongs to District Amritsar and since his initial recruitment as Clerk on 23.09.1983 till now has remained posted in District Amritsar almost 23 years.

The petitioner admittedly has served his present place of posting as Senior Assistant for the last three years and is also liable to serve anywhere in the State of Punjab being a member of a State cadre.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
