By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount of ₹1,74,471/- to him along-with interest @ 18% per annum and also to decide the legal notice/representation dated 08.03.2018 (P-2) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 08.03.2018 (P-2), in a time bound manner.

3. In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondents are directed to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice

dated 08.03.2018 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations that too, by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the afore-said legal notice as well as in view of judgments passed by this Court in CWP No. 13039 of 1999, titled as **Kirat Gopal vs. Haryana Vidyut Parsaran Nigam Ltd & others; decided on 20.03.2000 (P-3)** and CWP No. 1318 of 2009, titled as **Ram Pal vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. And others; decided on 08.01.2010 (P-4)**, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any inaction of the respondents, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
