The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking quashing of the impugned notices dated 07.07.2018 and 09.02.2018 (appended as Annexures P-5 & P-4), issued by respondents No.2 & 3. A further prayer has also been made for directing respondents No.1 & 2 to regularize the account by re-scheduling the same.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
