Vide order dated 20.11.2009 passed by respondent No.1, general directions have been issued to grant notional benefits in all cases in pursuance of judgment dated 19.03.2013 (Annexure P-4) rendered in CWP No. 2800 of 2011 as is made out from Annexure R-1. Vide communication dated 19.12.2014, it has been clarified that the notional benefits in terms of the directions be released by all the Drawing and Disbursing Authorities. It has been further clarified that the petitioners shall be deemed to have been appointed as Lecturers with effect from 15.12.2006, the date from which candidates similarly situated to the petitioners had joined and their pay will be notionally fixed. In view of this, nothing survives in the present writ petition. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved, they are free to move representation to the competent authority which shall look into the

matter and pass appropriate orders as per law.
