Petitioner (*Kesar Singh*) while serving on a Class-IV post on regular basis in the Department of Agriculture, Punjab, was transferred from Patiala to SAS Nagar vide order dated 30.06.2017 (**Annexure P-2**) which was impugned in the present writ petition.

Grievance is that the transfer was against the Transfer Policy as the petitioner was due to retire within ten months from the date of the transfer on attaining the age of superannuation of sixty years on 30.06.2018.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner stands retired from service.

“Dismissed as Infructuous”.
