Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to revise and recalculate the retiral benefits including pension, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund and arrears of salary by granting him the first time bound promotional scale after completion of 9 years of service in terms of instructions dated 23.04.1990 (P-1).

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though a legal notice dated dated 12.04.2018 (P-4) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any response has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.1 to decide the afore-said legal notice (P-4) in a time bound manner.

3. In view of afore-said aspects but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 or any other officer competent to deal with the matter, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 12.04.2018 (P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
