Present petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India has been filed for quashing the Award No.3 (Supplementary) dated 12.11.2017 (Annexure P/3).

Counsel could not point out how the petitioner has locus standi as there is even no whisper in the writ petition as to whether the land of the petitioner stands acquired. The writ petition has been filed challenging the authority of the Collector to pass the award. In the absence of any such specific pleadings this Court does not deem it a fit case to proceed in the absence of any locus standi.

Faced with this situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file afresh on the same cause of action with better particulars.

Ordered accordingly.
