Petitioner, who initiated the partition proceedings of land measuring 87 kanals and 10 marlas on account of his purchase of 03 kanals of land vide sale deed dated 15.09.2013, is aggrieved against the order of the Financial Commissioner dated 24.05.2018 (Annexure P-4), whereby the partition proceedings which were finalised have been set aside on the ground of proper notice having not been served upon the other co-sharers, who were arrayed as respondents in the partition proceedings and who had preferred the ROR before the Financial Commissioner.

Counsel at the very outset submitted that the application for partition was filed on 23.06.2006 (Annexure P-1). The matter has been remanded to the Assistant Collector and only prayer is that the matter be expedited by the Revenue Authorities. In such circumstances, he did not challenge the order on merits.

The request being fair, the writ petition is disposed of without issuing notice to opposite party as there is no dispute qua the above facts and circumstances.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 – Assistant Collector, Farrukhnagar, Gurugram, to finalise the proceedings at the earliest preferably within one year.
