Petitioner-Bodh Raj has retired from the post of Assistant Manager on superannuation on 29.02.2012 from the services of Patiala Central Cooperative Bank. His retiral benefits were withheld on account of the pending charge-sheets and on conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings, the due retiral benefits were released to the petitioner on 20/28.05.2014.

The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking payment of interest on delayed payments of retiral benefits, although no instruction, rule or regulation has been produced to substantiate such claim.

Be that as it may in the light of objection on behalf of the respondents that no writ would be maintainable against the Cooperative Society, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal the present writ petition to enable his client to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
