JASPAL SINGH, J.

Through instant petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release and disburse the pension and other retiral benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of accrual till actual payments.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though petitioner served legal notice dated 12.06.2018 (P-10) upon the respondents but till date no final decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide aforesaid legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-
Additional Director General of Police (Jails), Punjab, Chandigarh to look into

the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice (P-10) and to take a conscious decision, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
