This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to conduct the BPL survey of the petitioner and issue a BPL card to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after the issuance of the BPL card on the basis of survey in 2007, the parents of the petitioner have since died and the petitioner has constituted a separate family.

Learned counsel for the State states that in such an eventuality ID number of BPL held by father of the petitioner will be transferred in the name of the petitioner on making such an application by the petitioner supported by the necessary documents on record.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- ADC-cum-CEO, DRDA, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana to consider the case of the petitioner and needful be done expeditiously on filing an application by the petitioner. Let such an application be filed within four weeks from today and finality be accorded to the same within four weeks thereafter.
