JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

Contentends that consequent to the notice of motion order, the petitioner has been promoted as District Treasury Officer w.e.f. 29.9.2016 and all the payments for the relevant period have been made to him. However, the interest thereupon has not been paid.

Considering the fact that the main relief has been granted and only interest remains to be paid, the State is directed to examine the case of the petitioner with regard to the interest on the delayed payment and take a final decision in the matter within 8 weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is not satisfied with the decision taken by the competent authority, he shall have the liberty to either revive the present petition or to file a

fresh one within eight weeks of taking such a decision.
