By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representations dated August 04, 2016 (P-6) and August 26, 2016 (P-7) in respect of granting the pay scale of Executive Officer as well as benefit of ACP Grade II and III, after completion of 10 years and 20 years of service along with all consequential benefits.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though petitioner made various representations including representations dated August 04, 2016 (P-6) and August 26, 2016 (P-7) but till date the benefit of ACP Grade II and III has not so far been extended. Even the aforesaid representations did not fetch any reply. Learned counsel for the

petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to deal with and dispose of the aforesaid representations (P-6 & P-7) within some specified period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the above said representations (P-6 & P-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any of the order (s) passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court or to have recourse to other remedies available under the law.
