Although the petitioner has approached this Court for seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned inquiry report dated 11.07.2017 but he has fairly submitted that the appeal against the said inquiry report has already been preferred under the provisions of the Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002 (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Regulations’). He has thus changed his prayer in the present writ petition for seeking a direction to the appellate authority before whom the said appeal has been filed i.e. Director General Health Services, Haryana, to decide the same as early as possible.

Keeping in view the innocuous prayer made by the learned counsel for petitioner, present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Director General Health Services, Haryana who is stated to be seized of the appeal against the inquiry report dated 11.07.2017 to decide the same as early as possible within a period of three weeks from the date of passing of this order by following the principles of natural justice.
