MAHESH GROVER, J.(ORAL)

By this order we will dispose of three civil writ petitions bearing CWP nos. 19210, 19475 and 19485 of 2018.

The petitioners had questioned the restriction upon regular employees to be considered for admission to the course in question, even though the advertisement specifically stated that the course shall be open to both regular and contractual employees.

After we issued notice of motion and granted an interim benefit to the petitioners (in CWP no. 19210 of 2018) permitting them to participate in the counselling, the respondents have done so and have stated that all the regular candidates would be considered for the process of admission to the course regardless of the fact whether they have approached this Court or not.

Since the primary grievance of the petitioners stand redressed and they being permitted to participate in the admission process, instant petitions have been rendered infructuous and the same are disposed of as such.

Needless to say that petitioners and other similarly situated

persons shall be granted the admission subject to their eligibility and merit.

All the pending applications are also disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
