This petition is filed by 5 petitioners who have passed their B.Ed. Course from the Indira Gandhi National Open University (for short 'IGNOU'). They took admission in Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra for B.Ed. Course in additional subjects. It is alleged that petitioner No. 1 took admission in B.Ed. (Punjabi), petitioners No. 2 and 3 in B.Ed. (Sanskrit) and petitioners No. 4 and 5 in B.Ed. (English).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to a decision of this Court in CWP No. 15821 of 2018 titled as "**Mahaveer Singh and Others** Vs. **Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and another**" decided on 06.07.2018 in which the petitioners had also done their B.Ed. Course from the IGNOU and took admission in Kurukshetra University for doing B.Ed. Course in additional subjects. They were also not allowed to appear in the examinations on the ground that they had not passed their B.Ed. course from the State of Haryana. It is submitted that the petitioners in the present petition

are also similarly situated and may also be allowed to take examinations in the B.Ed. Course in their respective additional subjects.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly conceded that examinations of the petitioners of their additional subjects have already been over.

In view of the above, once the examinations are over, no relief can be granted to the petitioners in this petition and hence, the writ petition is dismissed.
