By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay retiral benefits to him including arrears of gratuity and leave encashment after counting his whole service as he had been granted continuity of service by the Industrial Tribunal and pay the above retiral benefits and other arrears along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated 24.04.2017 (P-3) was made to the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken thereof. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-3), in a time bound manner.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 24.04.2017 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law and/or to approach this Court.
