Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to refix their pay in the light of the decision passed by this High Court in CWP No.16084 of 1997 and CWP No.45818 of 2000 and as per letters dated 16.03.2017 & 28.03.2017 (P-3 & P-4) issued by State of Haryana and pay the arrears thereof with interest @ 12% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though a representation dated 09.01.2018 (P-7) followed by legal notice dated 03.05.2018 (P-8) was made to the respondents but till date no response has been received. He further submits that petitioners feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 03.05.2018 (P-8) in the light of judgment as well as letters referred to above in para no.1 of this order, within some stipulated period.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 03.05.2018 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in the light of judgment as well as letters referred to above in para no.1 of this order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law and/or to approach this Court.
