The grievance of the petitioner is that the proceedings pending before respondent No.3 have not been concluded despite its pendency for the last 1-1/2 years. Zimni orders have been appended to the petition to bring home the point.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the material on record as also the appraisal of his grievance, we are of the opinion that the instant petition can be disposed of without issuance of notice of motion to the other side on account of the directions that we intend to pass.

The Asstt.Collector Ist Grade, before whom proceedings are pending, will decide the matter as expeditiously as possible but not later than four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

We make it clear that no untoward adjournment shall be granted to either of the parties and even if adjournment has to be

granted, it shall be supported by reasons.
