The petitioner is an aspirant for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor in Chemistry with Multani Mal Modi College, Patiala-respondent No.3.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 6.8.2018, following order was passed :-

“The petitioner has competed for the post of Assistant Professor in Chemistry, to be appointed with the Multani Mal Modi College, Patiala-respondent No.3.

The grievance of the petitioner is that out of twelve persons short-listed and called for interview, two candidates namely Ms. Anupama Parmar and Ms. Nidhi Rani Gupta are ineligible being overage. That apart, one candidate namely Sanjiv Kumar has not cleared the

mandatory National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by UGC.

Before proceeding further, Mrs. Anu Chatrath Kapoor, Addl. A.G. assisted by Mrs. Anju Sharma, DAG, Punjab is directed to verify the facts as the recommendations have to be approved by the Government before issuance of the appointment letter.

Let requisite number of copies of the paper book be furnished to the State counsel during the course of the day.

For consideration, adjourned to 28.8.2018.

Ms. Monika Chhibber Sharma, Sr. DAG, Punjab, on instructions from Mr. Jai Singh Rana, Sr. Assistant, D.P.I. (Colleges), Punjab, Mohali states that Mr. Sanjeev Kumar possesses PHD prior to 2009 and therefore is exempted from clearing the NET exemption as per UGC Regulations, whereas the upper age limit for appointment of Assistant Professor is 60 years.

Be that as it may, counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the petitioner having offered appointment as Assistant Professor in Chemistry by respondent No.3, the present writ petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
