The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate order/direction, in view of the order dated 27.04.2011 (Annexure P-2), passed by this Hon'ble Court in CWP no. 11223 of 2009 and the order dated 06.08.2013 (Annexure P-3), passed by this Hon'ble Court in LPA No. 721 of 2012, and do the needful keeping in mind the parameters laid down by this Hon'ble Court in CWP No. 20545 of 2009, titled as "Anti-Corruption and Crime Investigation Cell Vs. State of Punjab and others", decided on 09.04.2013 (Annexure P-4). Besides above, several other prayers *qua* compliance of provisions of Section 16(3), 17(4) & (5), 24 of the Haryana School Education Act, 1995 as well as Rules 30(1)(a)(xxvi), (xxvii), 158 and 159 of the Haryana School Education Rules, 2003 and quashing of notification dated 28.01.2014 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.1 i.e. School Education Department, Government of Haryana, being defective, bad in law and contrary to the orders/directions dated 09.04.2013 (Annexure P-4) of this Court in CWP No. 20545 of 2009, have also been made.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at this stage, the writ petition is premature, therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again, if need so arises.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
