Present writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to take suitable action on representation dated 28.06.2018 whereby the irregularities and embezzlement on part of respondent No.5 were highlighted.

On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Sitta, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4. Copy supplied.

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter-alia contended that with regard to the irregularities and embezzlement highlighted on part of respondent No.5, B.D.P.O., Sudhar had enquired the matter and submitted report dated 24.01.2018 which was sent to D.D.P.O., Ludhiana and

observations were recorded that fraud was committed, but still no action is being taken on his report.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1 to decide representation dated 28.06.2018 of the petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously preferably within a period of three months.
