JASPAL SINGH, J.

Through instant petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 21.05.2018 (P-12).

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide aforesaid legal notice (P-12), within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1- Chairman, Board of Directors, Sugarfed, The Punjab State Federation of Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded

by the petitioner in legal notice (P-12) and to take a conscious decision, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
