JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has competed for the post of Member in the Child Welfare Committee, Ludhiana constituted under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. He claims that he is more meritorious than the private respondent No.4 - Sanjay Maheshwari and, therefore, he has sought the quashing of the notification dated 26.07.2018 notifying the selection and constitution of the Child Welfare Committees for different Districts in the State of Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioner heard. It is apparent that the notification dated 26.07.2018, which is sought to be quashed, has not been appended with the writ petition. Hence on this ground itself the petition deserves to be dismissed as it is a settled law that for a writ of certiorari the impugned orders/notifications are required to be placed on record with the writ petition. It is also settled law that the Courts in writ jurisdiction cannot make a roving inquiry into the comparative merits of the selected candidates.

Dismissed.
