RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J. (ORAL):

The limited prayer in this petition, at the instance of the petitioner, which is a parent association of Delhi Public School, Samalkha, District Panipat, is that a direction may be issued to the Fee and Fund Regulatory Committee, to decide its application dated 29.07.2016, filed in terms of Section 158(A) of the Haryana School Education Rules 2003 (for short “Rules 2003).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per Section 158(A) of the Rules 2003, the Fee and Fund Regulatory Committee at the Divisional Level, under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner, would decide the complaint so received, within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the respondents has not objected to the innocuous prayer made by the petitioner.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.5, who is allegedly seized of the complaint

made by the petitioner to decide the same within a period of 60 days which may be counted from the date of receipt of copy of this order, but not beyond that.
