MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has filed this writ petition with a prayer that the condition with regard to the age as contained in the prospectus and extracted herebelow be altered :-

“4. The candidates (including fresh candidates of NCT Delhi) should not be less than 17 years and not more than 22 years of age as on 31.12.2018. However, for the reserve categories (SC/BC), there will be relaxation of 5 years in the maximum age. For in-service candidates of all categories, the maximum age limit is 50 years. Candidates attaining 17 years on 1st January 2019 or later will not be eligible.”

No plausible argument has been offered in support of the prayer made.

The prescription of age by a institution desiring of attracting human resources for the educational course that it offers is an affair that has to be governed by the rules and regulations

governing the said institute. The courts would have no role in interfering with such conditions that are applicable uniformly to all the aspirants.

Dismissed.
