This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing of the letter (Annexure P-5), order dated 14.06.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 14 of the Act (ibid) and possession notice dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) under Section 13(4) of the Act (ibid) issued by respondent No.1 bank. A further prayer has been made in the present petition for directing the respondents not to create any third party rights qua the property in question.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to appropriate remedy as available to her, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies, as may be available to her, in accordance with law.
