The petitioner seeks a direction for allotment of alternative plot in lieu of Plot No.G-122, measuring 290.10 square meter, Sector 27-28, Rohtak, which was allotted to her on 27.03.2018.

The case of the petitioner is that after the allotment, she was required to pay Rs.27,43,284/- which were duly deposited. Thereafter, enhanced/additional amount of Rs.2,44,746/- was also deposited vide receipt dated 23.04.2018. The petitioner went at the site and found that though the plot allotted to her was a corner plot but it was not in existence at the site as the area of said plot had already been utilized for the widening of HUDA road. On coming to know this fact, the petitioner made a representation dated 26.04.2018 requesting for allotment of alternative plot. Since HUDA authorities have given no response, hence this writ petition.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of allegations but without expressing any views on merits, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Administrator, HUDA, Rohtak and the Estate Officer, HUDA, Rohtak to verify the facts averred by

the petitioner and take an appropriate decision regarding allotment of alternative corner plot to her within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
