Learned counsel for respondent No. 2-Reliance General Insurance Company, has agreed to grant Rs. 4,50,000/- (Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand), over and above the amount granted by learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Sonapat. This amount is acceptable to the appellants as full and final settlement. Statements of learned counsel for the parties to this effect have been recorded separately.

In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No. 2-Reliance General Insurance Company, to produce a demand draft for Rs.4,50,000/- within one month from today, before the learned Tribunal below, for onward disbursement of the settled amount to the appellants in proportion already arrived at by it, against proper receipt and identification, in accordance with law, failing which the enhanced amount shall carry interest @ 12% per annum till payment.
