JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner is serving as a Lecturer in Mathematics since 13.05.2010 and was posted against one of the two sanctioned posts at Government Senior Secondary School NTC, Rajpura, Patiala.

The present writ petition was filed apprehending her shifting out from the school in view of the rationalization Policy, whereby due to reduction in the strength of the students in a particular school some of the teachers were required to be shifted out to be posted at the school wherever the students would be available in the particular subject.

The grievance raised is that the Teacher/Lecturer who was posted in the school at Rajpura against the demanded post i.e. on temporary basis was required to be shifted out first.

Upon notice Mrs. Anu Chatrath Kapoor, Additional Advocate General, Punjab filed reply by way of affidavit dated 10.10.2018 of Jyoti Chawla, Assistant Director Office of DPI (Secondary), Punjab, SAS Nagar, Mohali. Para nos.3 & 4 of the same reads as under:-

“ That list of surplus teachers was issued vide Memo No.15/132/18E-1(3) dated 05.07.2018 wherein the name of the petitioner appeared in the said list. Thereafter the said list was re-examined by the Department and a fresh list was circulated. In that list, the petitioner's name was not reflected. Thus, the petitioner is till now working as Lecturer Mathematics at Government Senior Secondary School, NTC, Rajpura. Thus the grouse of the petitioner has been redressed.

That the present writ has been filed in the anticipation of transfer. However, the petitioner has not been transferred till now. The present writ petition is premature as the petitioner has not been transferred till now. ”

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner has agreed that nothing more survives for adjudication.

Disposed of as infructuous.
