The petitioners are seeking quashing of the order dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-7), whereby persons juniors to the petitioners have been promoted as PGT English and the petitioners have been considered ineligible for promotions. Further directions is being sought to be issued to respondents to consider the cases of the petitioners for promotions to the posts of TGT English.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the notification dated 11.04.2012 (Annexure P-2), whereby essential qualification for promotion to the post of PGT English is B.A. with at least 50% marks in English as an elective subject and two year diploma in Elementary Education.

A perusal of the above notification shows that B.Com. with English as elective subject is not eligible for promotion to the post of PGT English. However, for promotion as PGT Mathematics, essential qualification is B.A./B.Sc./B.Com with at least 50% marks in Mathematics

as an elective subject and two year diploma in Elementary Education. These rules are very clear that for promotion to the post of TGT English, a person should have done B.A. with at least 50% marks in English as an elective subject.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to challenge the vires of above said Rules/instructions being contrary to the NCTE guidelines.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
