By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the length of service rendered by him in privately managed, Government Aided School i.e. S.D. Boys School, Nabha since 1978 i.e. 10th August, 1978 and to release the benefits and other retiral dues as well as arrears along with interest @ 12% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation dated 22.02.2018 (P-8) was made to the respondents but till date no final decision has been taken thereon. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the above said representation (P-8), in a time bound manner.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- District Education Officer, Sangrur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 22.02.2018 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
