By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears of contributory provident fund @ 10% of total salary along with interest @ 9% p.a. from due date i.e. 01.04.1984 in compliance of order dated 06.05.2015 and further to release the interest @ 9% p.a. on arrears of pay on account of revision of pay scales from 01.01.2010 and for delay in making the payment of gratuity onwards and further arrears of pay on account of revision in pay scale benefits like ADA etc. till payment.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various legal notices dated 17.05.2018, 31.05.2018 & 08.06.2018 (P-10 to 12 respectively) were made to the respondents but till date neither any reply has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said legal notices (P-10 to P-12), in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notices dated 17.05.2018, 31.05.2018 & 08.06.2018 (P-10 to 12) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
