This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the preliminary exam held on 15.1.2017 along with impugned preliminary examination result dated 7.2.2017 (Annexure P-2) declared for the posts of Civil Judge (Junior Division) cum-Judicial Magistrate along with subsequent proceedings and recommendation notice/letter dated 9.7.2018 (Annexure P-8) for main exam.

Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The prayer in the present petition is that Punjab Civil Service (Judicial Branch) Preliminary Examination 2017 was held on 15.1.2017 as well as the result thereof was declared on 7.2.2017. The only ground that has been raised before us in support of the petition is that Mr. Balwinder Sharma, who was the Registrar (Recruitment) at the relevant time is facing serious charges in the similar exam i.e. Haryana Civil Services Examination, which was held at some point of time. Therefore, according to the petitioner

examination by Punjab Civil Services held on 15.1.2017 as well as the result, which was declared on 7.2.2017, both are liable to be declared as illegal and void.

At the outset, we find that the preliminary exam was held on 15.1.2017 and the result was declared on 7.2.2017. Admittedly, the petitioner did not succeed in the preliminary examination but failed. The present petition was filed on 4.8.2018 before this Court which itself denotes lack of bona fide intention of the petitioner in putting the challenge as aforesaid.

There is no merit in the petition.
