Convict/Petitioner-Taqdir was granted 25 days Agricultural Parole vide order dated 10.07.2018 Annexure P-1 passed by Divisional Commissioner, Rohtak. In compliance the petitioner was concededly released on 19.07.2018 and directed to surrender on 14.08.2018.

Criminal Appeal filed by the petitioner against his conviction and sentence for life imprisonment for offences punishable under Sections 302, 307 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code has been dismissed by a Division Bench of this Court on 30.07.2018. The petitioner thus has filed the present petition seeking one week extension in aforesaid parole to enable him to properly file an appeal by engaging a counsel of his choice, before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

stated that there is no provision for extension and a convict is entitled to only a total of six weeks parole during the entire year.

It is conceded that the petitioner has only availed three weeks of Parole for the present year and the remaining three weeks remain to be availed.

After hearing Counsel for the parties, this Court finds that the reasons for which extension in Parole is sought is justified. Therefore, it is felt that the ends of justice would be met if the prayer for one weeks extension is accepted, however, to be deducted from his over all entitlement of Parole for the year concerned.

Accordingly **one week extension in Parole is granted** in terms and conditions of the order dated 10.07.2018 and the consequent release order dated 18.07.2018. Petitioner-Taqdir would surrender before the Appropriate Authority on or before 21.08.2018.

Allowed of in the above terms.
