1. In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court dated 15.11.2010 (Annexure P/4).

2. Petitioner is stated to have been appointed as an office cleaner on 01.09.1979. His services were dispensed on 30.08.1984. In this regard, a demand notice was issued in the year 1985 and thereafter it was withdrawn in the year 1987. On 17.12.1994 fresh demand notice was issued. Thereafter, reference was decided on 15.11.2010 against the petitioner. Hence, the present petition was filed on 23.12.2014.

3. Perusal of dates and events it is evident that petitioner had slept over the matter. Thus, there is a delay and laches on the part of the petitioner as is evident from the date of termination, first demand notice, withdrawal of demand notice, second demand notice and further

challenging the award dated 15.11.2010 in the month of December, 2014.

In view of these facts and circumstances, no interference is called for in respect of award dated 15.11.2010.

4. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
