Punishment Order dated 23.11.2005 was passed against the petitioner whereby Stoppage of one annual increment with cumulative effect along with recovery of Rs.13,77,000/- approximately was imposed for shortage of wheat stocks. The appeal filed before the Appellate Authority was dismissed vide order dated 13.02.2018. The statutory review petition was filed on 13.7.2018 which is stated to be pending.

The grievance is that now recoveries in the proportion of 60% from the salary has been started since last two months inspite of the statutory review pending before the Appellate Authority.

Upon notice respondents have put in appearance through Mr. ADS Sukhija, Panel Advocate. He states that the Appellate Authority

before whom the statutory review has been filed will decide the same within

06 months from today.

In response counsel for the petitioner has no objection if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the reviewing Authority to decide the review within six months.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Reviewing Authority to decide the statutory review by passing a speaking order within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Future recovery from today shall not be effected till the disposal of the statutory review.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the parties on payment of usual charges.
