Petitioner is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 23.05.2012 (Annexure P-4) vide which the electricity supply to the tube-well of the petitioner has been disconnected and further directions to the respondents to restore the electric supply to the agriculture power pump of the petitioner.

After going through the writ petition and additional affidavit of filed by the respondents No.1 to 4, petitioner does not have figured in six names against whom investigation has been carried out. However, in all the affidavits filed, the respondents have failed to show that petitioner was not resident of the village and without any investigation the tubewell connection has been cancelled.

In view of the reply filed by the respondents No.1 to 4 and investigation report (Annexure R-1), present writ petition is allowed the respondent/Corporation is directed to restore the tubewell connection and further directed to the respondents to pay a costs of Rs.30,000/- to the petitioner.
