The petitioner prays that there are numerous encroachments in the village which deserve to be removed and in this regard he has made a representation to the Deputy Commissioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we are of the opinion that the petitioner would have remedies in law in invoking provisions of Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands Regulation Act to initiate proceedings against all the encroachers. Merely because they are numerous in number ought not be a detriment.

Hence, instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedies in law. Deputy Commissioner may also look into the grievance of the petitioner.
