This order shall dispose of CWP No.2850 of 2014 and CWP No.21802 of 2017 together as common questions of law and facts are involved in both these petitions. For reference, facts are being taken from CWP No.2850 of 2014.

Petitioner(s) are seeking direction to the respondents to grant the same pay scale and allowances to them as admissible to their counterparts

working in Government Schools and to extend the benefit of grant-in-aid

scheme to the primary department of the school.

As per written statement filed by respondent No.4-Managing Committee, petitioners have been appointed purely on temporary basis by the Managing Committee of the Society. It was a stop gap arrangement and their appoints were not made on regular basis. The respondent school is being run by the a society namely Chhotu Ram Kisan Shiksha Samiti, Jind by raising funds from its members and other respectable persons of the society. No grant-in-aid is being extended on the posts, where the petitioners are working.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has referred to the order dated 12.02.2015 passed by this Court in **Raj Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others**, CWP No.2602 of 2013 (decided on 12.02.2015), whereby it has been observed that vide notification dated 07.05.2013 issued by the State of Haryana, a special Educational Tribunal has been set up, where the petitioners will have efficacious alternative remedy.

In view of the said fact, the petitioners are relegated to their alternative remedy before the concerned Education Tribunal.

Both the petitions i.e. CWP No.2850 of 2014 and CWP No.21802 of 2017 stand disposed of accordingly.
