The petitioner is seeking extension of parole on the ground that his wife is expecting a child in the coming week.

Reply by way of short affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda on behalf of the respondents is filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner is already on parole for six weeks w.e.f. 06.07.2018 upto today i.e. 18.08.2018

However, keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby allowed and the parole is extended for two weeks w.e.f. 18.08.2018 on the same bail bonds, furnished by the petitioner, at the time parole was initially granted to him. He is directed to surrender to the Jail authorities on the date of completion of two weeks to suffer the remaining sentence.
