JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 03.03.2015 (P-4) passed by respondent No.2, vide which 20% cut in pension of the petitioner for 10 years has been imposed and further request is for operation and implementation of the impugned order dated 03.03.2015 may be stayed.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has emerged that order dated 03.03.2015 (P-4) is already challenged by way of an appeal before respondent No.1 and till date no final decision has been taken.

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3. Without expressing anything on merit with regard to the impugned order dated 03.03.2015 as well as the facts and circumstances, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent No.1 to decide the appeal pending before it against the order dated 03.03.2015, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner still feels aggrieved by the appellate authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
