JASPAL SINGH, J

Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.1 to remove anomaly in their pay scale and grant arrears after refixation of pay and pension along with interest @ 12% as well as other consequential benefits w.e.f. the date the anomaly in the pay scale arose.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits though representation dated 25.05.2018 (P-5) was moved to the respondent(s) but till date no conscious decision has been taken by them. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to respondents to decide aforesaid representation, within a stipulated period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the

instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in representation dated 25.05.2018 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved against any of the order passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court as well as to have recourse to the other remedies available under law.
