The grievance of the petitioner is that a Marble Market has been developed by HUDA in Secor-21, Faridabad where the marble merchants have illegally encroached upon the Government/HUDA land abutting the road, for the purpose of storage of marbles. Similarly, they have procured illegal electricity connections from the electric polls as may be seen from the photographs on record. The encroachments on the public road coupled with illegal electricity supply through *kundi* connections has endangered the life and safety of residents of the area. It is further alleged that the petitioner has made several complaints to various quarters but no action is being taken by the authorities. The copies of complaints are appended with the writ petition.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into consideration the averments made in the writ petition, duly supported with photographs on record, it appears expedient to direct the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad and the Administrator, HUDA, Faridabad

to consider the complaints of the petitioner immediately and take necessary

remedial measures in accordance with law and principles of natural justice,
within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy
of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
