The petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondents No.1 to 4 to withdraw the contract with respondent No.5 by which he has been permitted to run a Red Cross Medical Store in De-Addiction Centre, Civil Hospital, Mansa.

It is pertinent to mention that the petitioner is running a medical shop in Mansa and has no personal injury on the opening of the Red Cross Medical Store in De-Addiction Centre, Civil Hospital, Mansa. It appears that it is a case of business rivalry, therefore, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner has no *locus standi* to maintain this petition. Hence, the same is hereby dismissed though without any order as to costs.
